TRAINING CURRICULUM

1 hour, 10 minutes on-ice instruction sessions, 1 hour scrimmage/game, classroom, dryland training or recreation each day.

A goalie coach will work with the goalies each day. Each session will be limited to 30 players plus goalies.

A typical day's session would be:

8:00 - 9:10	ON-ICE INSTRUCTION
9:35 - 10:10	RECREATION/DRYLAND
10:25 - 10:55	CLASSROOM
11:10 - 11:55	LUNCH
12:15 - 1:15	SCRIMMAGE/GAME

During recreation time there will be tennis, swimming or other recreational activities.

(Times will vary for the different age groups.)

This year the instructional groups will be divided into four age levels:

1. Mites 1 & 2- ages 8 and below
2. Squirts - ages 9 & 10
3. Pee Wees - ages 11 & 12
4. Girls - ages 14 & under
