## PERMIT FOR FIRES

It shall be unlawful for any person to start, conduct, or allow any fire on any property within the city without a permit issued as defined in Chapter 5, Section 540 of the Silver Bay City Code. Fires contained in a charcoal grill, camp stove, or other similar device is exempt from the required permit.

Fees Charged:
Open Burning for wood from trees, branches, or brush - \$5 per occurrence Open Burning must be in compliance with MN Statutes 88.16-88.171
Recreational Fires - \$5 annually from January 1 <sup>st</sup> – December 31 <sup>st</sup> . <i>Recreational Fires must be in compliance with MN State Fire Code 2007</i>
The City has the right to revoke a permit for any reason with no refunds.
