OLD BUSINESS

Arena Update – Carpenter updated on projects and clean up in the arena, working with the County to have doors fixed, and summer programs practicing inside until outdoor fields dry up.

Marina Update – Carpenter updated on ELI Yachts doing maintenance projects, including fixing electrical issues on the docks, and that they have expanded the marina hours. There is an increase in seasonal boaters.

Black Beach Campground Update – Carpenter updated the high occupancy rate of reservations for the season, the closure of the ATV trails are having on reservations, water being turned on for the season, summer staff hiring, and a campground host application being reviewed. There was discussion on expanding services to include ice sales and potential clothing.

Summer Programs- Carpenter updated summer programs have started with the remainder of programs starting in June. There was discussion on pickleball programs dates, adult basketball, and opening the weight room.

Multi-Modal Trailhead Center- Carpenter updated that the city has received notice of funding grant of \$515,909 from the Federal Highway Administration for the development of the Multi-Modal Trailhead Center.

Black Beach Park/E. Lakeview Drive Plan- Board reviewed the current plan for Black Beach Park/E. Lakeview Drive, that final engineering is being conducted. There was discussion on parking and rerouting of road to avoid campground.

Dog Park – Board discussed proposed dog park plans to be provided to the MN Design Team, that the City Economic Developer has been working with interested residents, possible locations, and enforcement of laws should any problems arise.
