Parks and Recreation Department

 - Softball (switched to wood bats has been a success)
 - Hockey

School Sports

- ~ 15 35 kids per class so high participation needed
- Fall football, volleyball, cross country
- Winter hockey and basketball
- Spring baseball, softball, trap shooting, track
- Significant travel time for games

Community Education

- Swimming / Water aerobics
- Exercise / yoga classes
- Open volleyball and basketball
- Salmon Classic fishing tournament

Silver Bay Blue Line Club

- Local hockey club for Silver Bay area with participants from Cook County as well
- County owned arena, City of SB operates
- Funded through registration fees, donations, fundraisers –
 North Shore Hockey Camp, tournaments
- ~80-100 kids majority in community are "hockey" families
- Outdoor rink project
 - Concrete base, new hockey boards, pickleball courts
 - Funding through donations, grants, volunteers and BLC
 - ~\$300K
