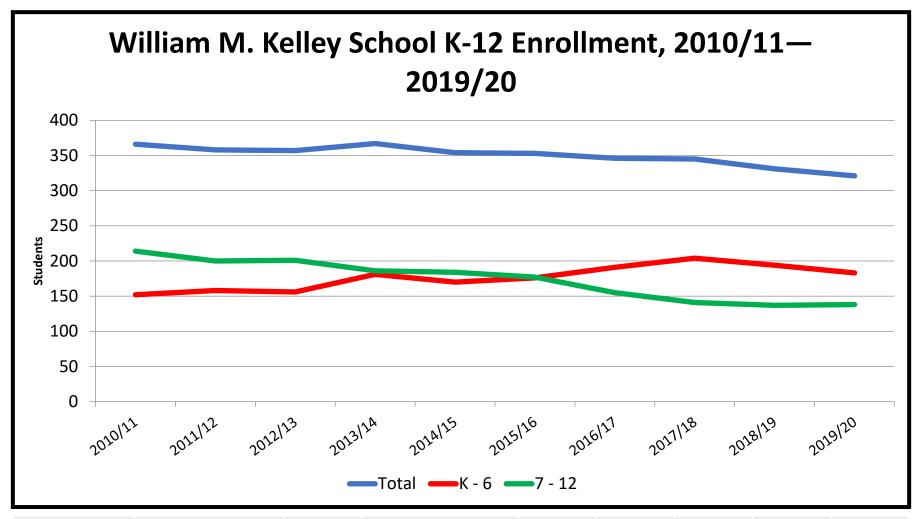

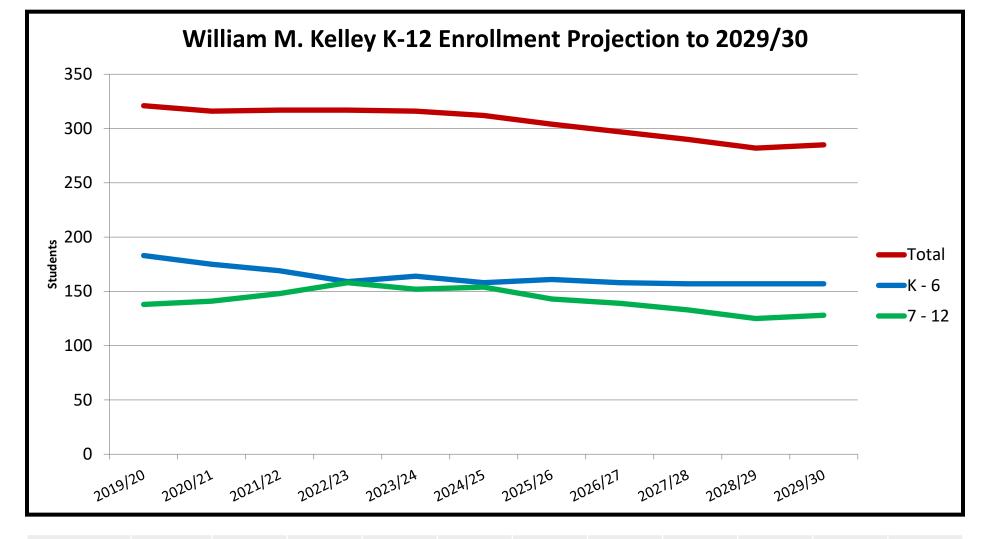

  - Messaging around enrollment projections and space needs



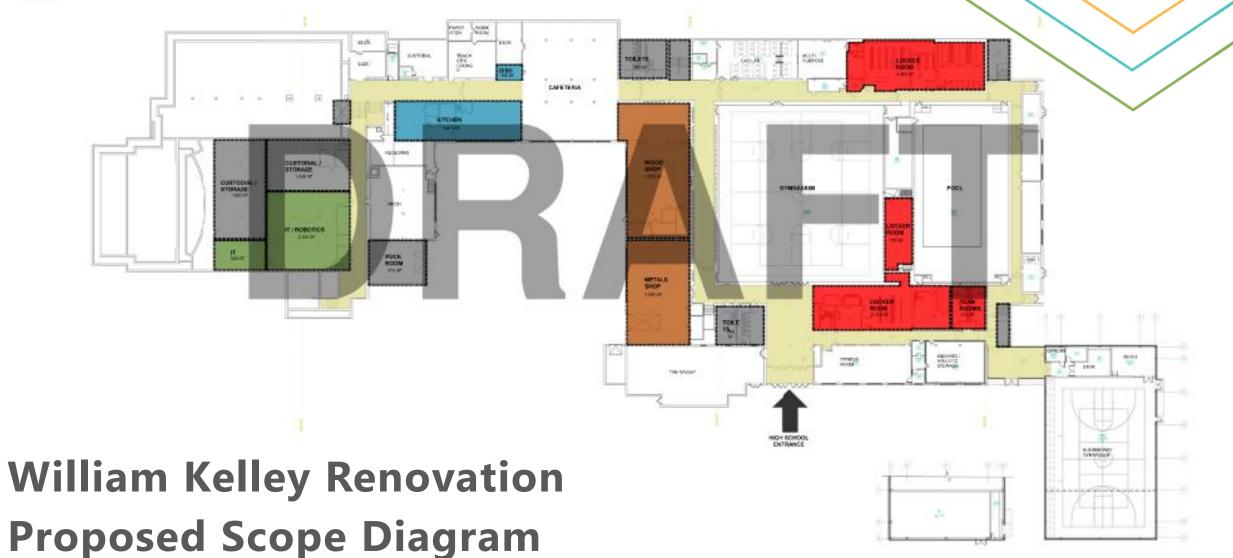
# **Proposed Scope Summary**

- Safety & Security:
  - Controlled entrance new main office with secure vestibule, add doors for security zones inside building
- Educational Adequacy:
  - Replace specialist spaces with new addition in place of current music wing (music, art, science, FACS)
  - Utilize current art, science, FACS for elementary / daycare demand
  - Renovate locker rooms & team rooms
  - Update kitchen equipment
  - Replace flooring and cabinets in rooms not renovated in last project

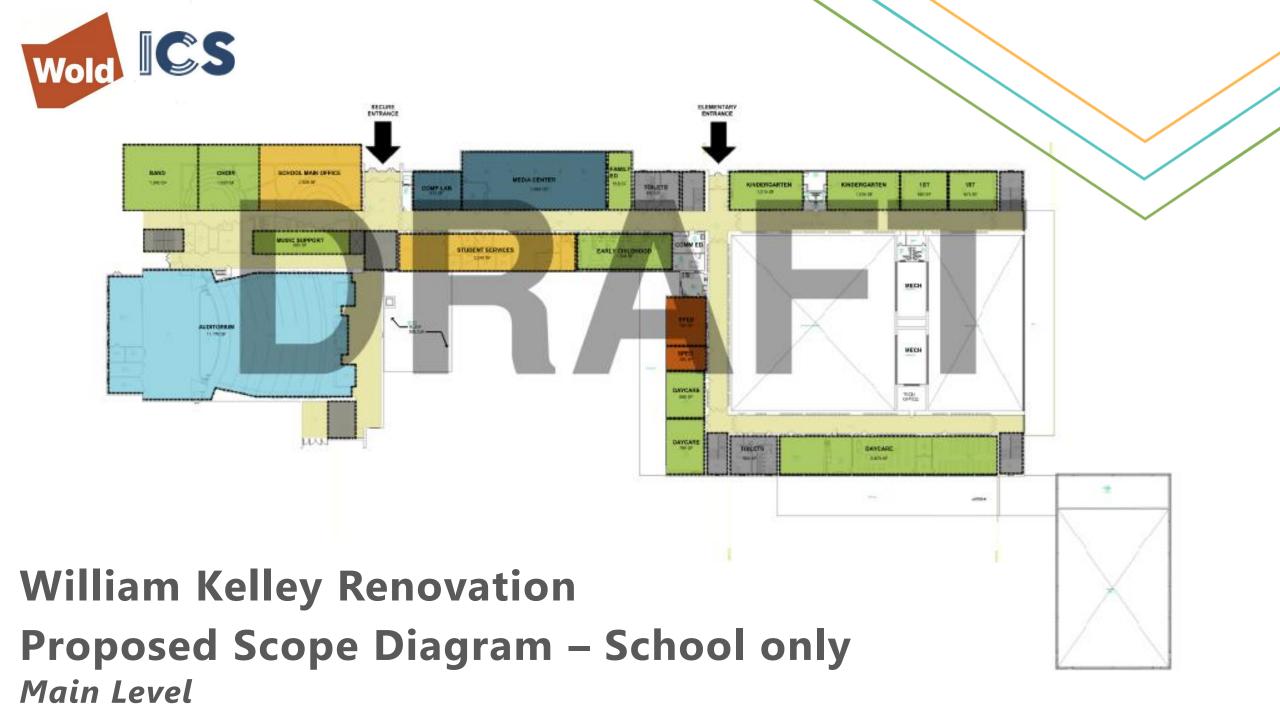
- Building Condition:
  - Finishes updates
  - ADA upgrades
  - Life Safety
  - Mech / Ventilation / IAQ
  - Building Envelope Upgrades
  - Update to LED Lighting
- Exterior Site / Athletics:
  - Turf Field (currently grass) with sound system & LED Lighting
  - Rotate Baseball & Softball Field
  - All-weather track

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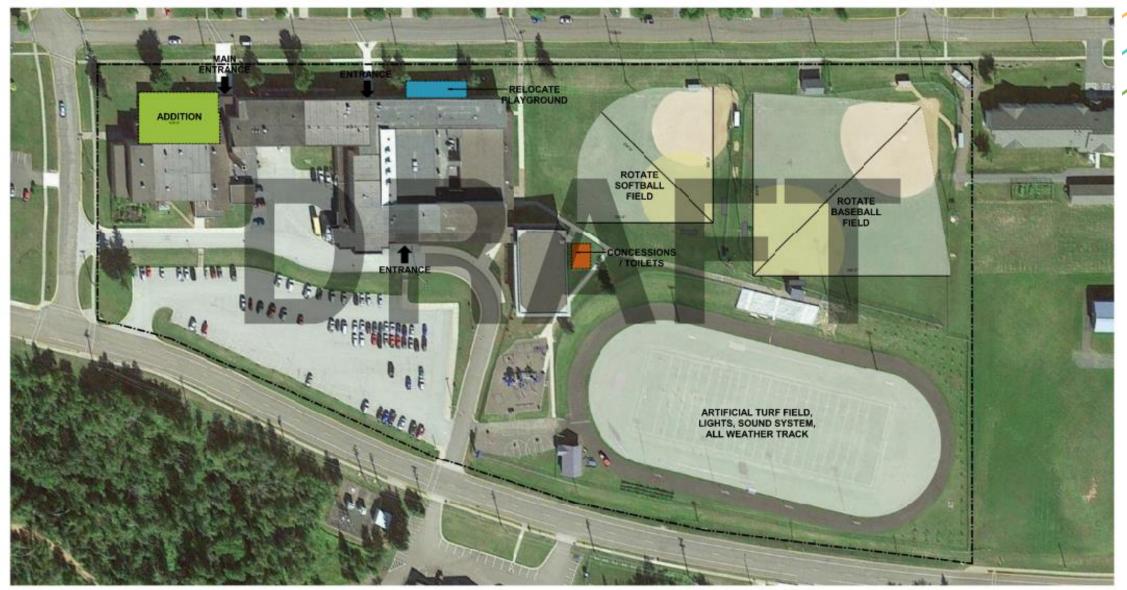
