Grant Access Easement for J&H Auto Expansion- Drown is working with owners of J&H and an adjacent land owner on the potential expansion of J&H. There was discussion on the option to provide an access easement across city property. Tabled until next meeting.

Alternate Location Options for Lake County HRA Housing Project- Drown provided information regarding the MN Workforce Housing Development Grant Program. There is a short application submission timeline and both Lake County HRA and Blue-Ribbon Builders are interested in applying for housing projects within the City. The preferred building area is behind the Shopping Center. Discussion regarding Mary MacDonald area

as an alternate area, leaving the Mary Mac building in place, current zoning and compliance of area, including the bus garage, maintaining the ballfield, and the possibility of Lake County HRA and Blue-Ribbon Builders applying for MN Workforce Housing grant cooperatively.
