FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

JULY 29, 2024

On June 28, 2024, President Joseph R. Biden Jr., granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Minnesota triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from the Severe Storms and Flooding that occurred June 16 – July 4, 2024. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Public Assistance (PA):	(Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

PA-Designated Areas:

Blue Earth, Carver, Cass, Cook, Cottonwood, Faribault, Fillmore, Freeborn, Goodhue, Jackson, Lake, Le Sueur, Murray, Nobles, Pipestone, Rice, Rock, St. Louis, Steele, Wabasha, Waseca, and Watonwan Counties.

Hazard Mitigation (HM):

(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas:

All areas in the State of Minnesota are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the state and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
