FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

JULY 29, 2024

On June 28, 2024, President Joseph R. Biden Jr., granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Minnesota triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from the Severe Storms and Flooding that occured June 16 – July 4, 2024. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:
