Treasurer's Report- November 2025

LMC Safety & Loss Control Training- Lisa Christenson- MN Cities Safety and Loss Control workshop on April 23, 2026 relating to elections and zoning. Cost of training is \$20, plus one night stay for \$145.44, normal meals and mileage.

Bolton & Menk DNR Outdoor Rec Grant Submission Proposal- Proposal was reviewed from Bolton & Menk to submit a grant application to the DNR Outdoor Rec program for the trailhead center seeking additional funding to cover items that were removed due to cut backs for a proposed cost of \$5000. The grant would reimburse up to 50% of the costs. Review deadline for applications is February 28th, making it difficult for the administration to complete due to city audit. Final applications are due end of March. Discussion regarding cost of grant submission, reducing costs to submit application for review, or have City Administrator complete and submit without DNR review. Motion by FitzGerald, second DeRosier to ask Bolton & Menk reduce cost to \$3000, and if not, city staff will submit. MOTION CARRIED.
